Overview of Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Beforehand the tutor creates a narrative of someone's story of how he/she got involved in the film industry and more specifically a writer and/or a director. The tutor can get inspired by the case studies of the WIFI (http://wifilmmooc.eu/index.php/case-study-library/). However, the tutor should not use gender pronouns (he/she). Instead, say "someone." Now, use gender to describe the same path. Discuss if there are any differences, what are the barriers of women in comparison to a man's and how does that influence the potential of a woman's career?
