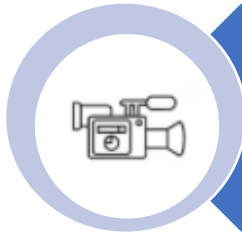

Courses to learn how to use recording equipment are essential to be able to work in this field.



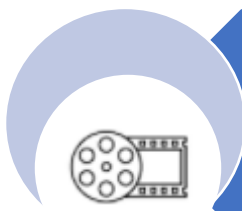
GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION
